<u>CCE acquires ready-to-build PV project in the Netherlands: Con-</u> <u>struction to start in May, completion by the end of 2024</u>

The project has all licences for operation and construction is scheduled to start before the summer. In the Marknesse project, for example, we have a grid connection with sufficient capacity to be able to integrate additional battery storage later,' explains Jörg Menyesch, Co-CEO of CCE Holding.

Martin Dürnberger, Co-CEO of CCE Holding: 'Realising for future is the mission that is driving CCE on the path to the energy transition in Europe. The project in the Netherlands is another important milestone for us on our way to becoming a leading European independent power producer.'
